Committee Reports:

- 1. Pontoon Ride:** Tabled.
- 2. Youth Hunt:** Cancelled for 2022.
- 3. Bucks Night:** To be held at Gibby's. Limited to 250 attendees. Chuck updated the club with changes to games and prices. Members need to get their registration turned in early. Bar guns need to be checked on to be sure there are enough tickets out.
- 4. Habitat/Fisheries:** Cost share was sent to Scott Wagner for prescribed burn.
